








INSULIN STORAGE GUIDE














Make sure that insulin is the last thing which you buy while you are out in the market and first thing to be stored once back at home, so that the **cool chain** is maintained



Once home, the **unused** insulin vial/pen should be stored in the refrigerator (2-8°C)

Store the products in a refrigerator and do not store in the Freezer





Once an insulin vial/pen is **opened** for use, it should be kept at room temperature. Only unopened vials/pens should be kept in the refrigerator

cloudy insulin should be kept horizontally during storage and those containing clear insulin can be stored either vertically/horizontally



While travelling, store the insulin vial/pen in a pouch with a refrigerated coolant gel pack or cooled thermoflasks with ice if the ambient temperature is expected to be higher than 30°C

While **travelling** by air, insulin should not be placed in the checked-in baggage to avoid exposure to extreme temperatures





Do not store your insulin near extreme heat or extreme cold. Never keep insulin in the freezer, direct sunlight or in the glove compartment of a car

Never leave the needle attached to the insulin pen




Do not use expired insulin even when stored properly
